The MAST PTSA Inc. has reached an agreement with Coast Driving School to offer an optional driver's education classroom instruction course.

The course will be taught by Ronald Conley, President of Coast Driving School. The purpose of this course is to establish a solid foundation for students in learning the basic principles of the road, how a car responds to different situations, what makes a good defensive driver, and the responsibility that goes along with having a license. The course will also prepare students for their written test that has to be taken at the Motor Vehicle Commission ("MVC"). The instructor is not permitted to administer the state test; however, a practice exam will be given.

There will be 10 classes onsite at MAST. Classes will be held in Room 318B every Thursday from 2:45pm to 4:45pm. Classes begin Thursday, February 2<sup>nd</sup> & continue every Thursday thereafter: 2/9, 2/16, 2/23, 3/1, 3/8, 3/15, 3/22, 3/29, and 4/5.

Attendance is mandatory; please check your schedules prior to registering.

Parents are responsible for transportation home and should be at MAST by 4:30 pm. Any student who becomes a discipline problem will be asked to leave the class and will not receive a refund. In the event that demand exceeds class size, priority will be given based upon date of birth.

Insurance discounts for completion of the class are based on each specific insurance company. Each student will be responsible for obtaining their permit at the MVC.

Classroom instruction and Behind the Wheel are two separate programs. MAST offers only the classroom instruction.

The cost for this program is \$150.00 due at the first class. Payment must be in the form of cash, money order or certified check made payable to Ronald Conley, President – Coast Driving School. Personal checks will **not** be accepted.

Dr. Christopher has informed us that we will need one parent each week to volunteer to sit in on the class and stay until the last student has been picked up. **Please check off any date(s) that you are available on the attached form.** We appreciate your time and effort to volunteer.
